2007 ASE NON-RESIDENT TUITION COMMITTEE

During the course of negotiations the parties discussed issues regarding tuition remission for graduate student employees in the bargaining unit. The parties have recognized the need to explore these issues more fully.

Therefore, the parties have agreed to create a labor-management committee to discuss conducting appropriate analyses that might alleviate impediments to providing funds for non-resident graduate student teaching assistants and similar titles that might be used to cover non-resident tuition.

The committee shall review regulations that affect whether and how state funds are used for paying for UC student fees and explore the various options regarding how non-resident tuition may be remitted.

The committee shall be comprised of an equal number of representatives from the UAW and the University, not to exceed eight (8) members in total.

The committee will meet regularly from January 1, 2008 through May 1, 2008.

The committee shall complete its discussions and make recommendations to the appropriate University officials.
