

ARTICLE 31: MEAL PERIODS AND ALLOWANCE

Employees will be given an unpaid thirty (30) minute meal period. Whenever possible, the meal period will be scheduled at the middle of the shift. When continuous operations are in effect, the Employer agrees to provide a thirty (30) minute paid meal period for each affected employee. Such designation must be approved in advance by the Employer.

Meal Allowance

Employees who unexpectedly (i.e. without prior notice or knowledge) work in excess of ten (10) hours in a workday, shall be provided a meal or a meal allowance of not more than ten dollars (\$10.00). Specifically excluded from this provision is daily or routine overtime prescheduled or prearranged before the employee reports to work.
