

ARTICLE 36. LABOR-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS

Meetings at reasonable intervals may be scheduled at the request of a full-time Union staff representative or the Labor Relations Manager for the purpose of informally discussing actual or potential employer-employee relations problems.

Such meetings are not considered to be meet and confer sessions and are not intended to add to, delete from, or otherwise modify the Agreement during its term, except that addenda to the Agreement are permitted by mutual agreement of the parties.
